• Undergraduate Entry Requirements:

- 1. Minimum 60% marks required from CBSE and ICSE boards.
- 2. Minimum 65% marks for other state boards.
- 3.IELTS 6.0 (with not less than 5.5 in all modules)
- 4. English language waiver offered to students securing more than 65% marks in Class 12th English.













Postgraduate Entry Requirements:

- 1. A minimum of 55% is required in a Bachelor's degree from a recognised university (University of Mumbai, University of Delhi).
- 2. A Minimum of 60% is required in a Bachelor's degree from other universities.
- 3. IELTS band score 6.5 (with not less than 6.0 in each module).
- 4. English language waiver to students securing more than 65% marks in Class 12th English.

2. Undergraduate Entry Requirements:

Diploma & Advanced Diploma:

1. Completion of 11th and 12th grades in the relevant field with a minimum of 60% in 12th grade.

Bachelor's Degree:

- 1. Completion of 11th and 12th grades in the relevant stream with a minimum of 70% in 12th grade.
- 2. IELTS score of 6.5 (not less than 6.0 in each module), TOEFL-iBT score of 79, Duolingo score of 110-130, and PTE score of 58-65.
- 3. GRE and SAT scores are required in some colleges, and GMAT score is needed for medical programs.

Postgraduate Entry Requirements:

PG Diploma:

- 1. Bachelor's Degree in a relevant field.
- 2. Need for work experience for some programs.
- 3. A minimum of 60% in the undergraduate degree.













Master's Degree:

- 1. Bachelor's Degree in a relevant field (4 years of education is required)
- 2. Need for work experience for some programs.
- 3. Minimum of 70% in the undergraduate degree.
- 4. IELTS score of 6.5 (not less than 6.0 in each module), TOEFL-iBT score of 88, Duolingo score of 110-130, and PTE score of 58-65.
- 4. Specific requirements, such as GRE, SAT, and GMAT scores, may vary by program and university.

Undergraduate Entry Requirements

- 1. Minimum overall percentage of 60% in 12th grade
- 2. IELTS overall score of 6.0 bands with not less than 5.5 in any module.
- 3. Some universities may ask for an entrance exam for courses like English TOLC-I and TIL

Postgraduate Entry Requirements

- 1. 12 years of schooling & 3 years of bachelor's accounting for a minimum of 15 years of education in a relevant field
- 2. Minimum 60% in a bachelor's degree
- 3. Interviews for admission into some courses
- 4. IELTS overall score of 6.0 bands with not less than 5.5 in any module





- 2. Need for Mathematics or Science for Computing and Engineering courses
- 3. 6.0 (6.0) IELTS / 50-58 (50-58) PTE
- 4. 7.0 IELTS or equivalent for Nursing

• POSTGRADUATE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. An excellent academic record in a Bachelor's Degree from a recognised university is necessary As per NOOSR Guide
- 2. Work experience in the field will be helpful.
- 3. 6.5 IELTS / 58-65 PTE
- 4. 7.5 IELTS OR Equivalent for Teaching/Nursing/Counselling/Social Work
- > For UG programs-Between 20,000 45,000 AUD/year



- 3. English proficiency test score (IELTS) is required; check with your preferred university for minimum band score requirements

• POSTGRADUATE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. A minimum score of 50-60% in undergraduate studies
- 2. GMAT or GRE score for students opting for management studies
- 3. Work experience and internships preferred in the relevant field of study by some universities
- 4. English language proficiency score like IELTS is required: check with your preferred university for minimum band score requirement
